Thank you for choosing Kevertin Pet Resort for your dog's daycare needs. Our mission is to provide your dog with a safe and healthy play environment to enrich their spirit, increase their social skills, offer an off-leash area to exercise their body, and give plenty of play time to stimulate their mind. Supervised by caring staff members trained in animal play, we offer a safe alternative to free-play in dog parks as well as give your dog exercise and attention during times that you are unable to do so. Please understand that our staff members, while trained in animal behavior and play groups, **are not certified dog trainers**. Daycare, for that reason, is for dogs that are already well-socialized and enjoy the company of other dogs. If you are looking to break a dog of his or her timid, fearful or other generally unsocial behaviors you may want to seek professional training assistance. In the meantime, we do offer individual play daycare programs that are still a great stimulant for the body and mind of a dog that may prefer the company of people over other dogs at this time.

We ask for at least a one-day-a-week commitment from day campers that wish to play with others so that we can provide a consistent and comfortable group for your dog to socialize and feel safe. Consistency and regularity are crucial for play groups because it reduces the stress of meeting new and unfamiliar dogs each and every day. Once you choose a day that best fits your schedule, your dog will automatically be scheduled each week for that day. Because space is limited and staff is scheduled according to our reserved campers, you will be charged for that day regardless of your camper's attendance.

The cost of initial evaluation is \$56.00. Please return your application and a copy of shot records at least a week prior to evaluation.

Weekly rates are as follows:

1 day a week: \$30.00
2 days a week: \$58.00
3 days a week: \$84.00
4 days a week: \$108.00
5 days a week: \$130.00

Our drop-off hours for day camp are 7:30 - 9:00 a.m. Please drop your camper off at our day camp building near the playground. That door will be locked at 9:00 when playtime begins. If you are after 9:00 please drop your camper off at the main office. Pick-up again will be at our day camp building and is between 4:30-6:00 p.m.
